

How to prepare for a home restoration project and what to expect

- 1. KEEP CHILDREN AND PETS AWAY FROM WORK AREA. DANGER KEEP OUT!
- 2. Be prepared for the noise. Crews generally start early in the morning. There will be constant noise during the construction process.
- 3. Remove all loose items from wall shelves and walls. Heavy machinery creates vibrations that may cause items to shift, move and fall.
- 4. Please move all recreational and motor vehicles while work is taking place. Job specific instructions will be provided throughout the project.
- 5. Large trucks and heavy machinery will be used to complete the project. This will impact your ability to move in, out and around your community.
- 6. The use of power tools may be needed to complete the approved work. Access to an outlet may be needed. **Please notify us if you have any concerns with this.**
- 7. All new concrete and asphalt must be kept off for at least 24 hours. At this time light foot traffic is allowed. Objects should not be stored on these surfaces for a least a week and cars should not be parked on new surfaces for 14 days.
- 8. Daily cleanup of the job site will be completed. Every effort is made to keep the community safe and clean during the project but it is a construction zone.
- 9. Communication and responsiveness is a top priority. Please feel free to contact us with any questions or concerns you may have. Our mission is to provide high quality work with as little impact on your community as possible.
