

How to prepare for a home restoration project and what to expect

- 1. KEEP CHILDREN AND PETS AWAY FROM THE WORK AREA. DANGER KEEP OUT!
- 2. Be prepared for the noise. Crews generally start early in the morning. There will be constant noise during the construction process. Work hours are 7 am to 3:30 pm but excessive noise will not start until after 8 am.
- 3. Remove all loose items from wall shelves and walls. Hammering creates vibrations that may cause items to shift, move and fall.
- 4. Access to your parking garage will be impacted during the entire project. The crews will do their best to keep the driving lane open.
- 5. Large delivery trucks and cranes will be used to load and unload materials and dumpsters. We will do our best to provide notice when they will be onsite.
- 6. The use of power tools may be needed to complete the approved work. Access to outlets will be needed. **Please notify us if you have any concerns with this.**
- 7. Reasonable daily cleanup of the job site will be completed. Every effort will be made to keep the parking garage clean and free from dust but this is a construction area.
- 8. Communication and responsiveness is a top priority. Please feel free to contact us with any questions or concerns you may have. Our mission is to provide high-quality work with as little impact on your community as possible.
