



## How to prepare for a home restoration project and what to expect

Please be advised that the interior construction work to your home is scheduled to begin on \_\_\_\_\_. Please see below for what to expect and what is needed by you to safely complete the work.

1. Please move all furniture and personal items at least 10 feet from the exterior wall with the patio door and balcony. (Please let us know if you will need assistance).
2. The need to relocate electrical switches and plug-ins near the patio door may be required to allow for the required additional wood framing to support the new balconies.
3. KEEP PETS AND CHILDREN AWAY FROM THE WORK AREA. DANGER KEEP OUT!
4. Patio doors will be screwed shut until the new balconies are installed.
5. Be prepared for your home to be cooler than normal due to the need to have proper ventilation.
6. Be prepared for the noise. The crew generally starts early in the morning. There will be constant noise during the construction process. Work hours are from 7:00 am to 5:00 pm.
7. Remove all loose items from wall shelves and walls. Hammering creates vibrations that may cause items to shift, move and fall.
8. Reasonable daily cleanup of the job site will be completed. Every effort will be made to keep the home clean and free from dust but this is a construction area. You may want to cover furniture or items outside of the barrier with painters poly.
9. The use of power tools may be needed to complete the approved work. Access to outlets will be needed. **Please notify us if you have any concerns with this.**
10. Communication and responsiveness is a top priority. Please feel free to contact us with any questions or concerns you may have. Our mission is to provide high-quality work with as little impact on your community as possible.
