

Siding Replacement Notice

Please be advised that the siding on the back of the building is scheduled to begin on ______ at 7:00 am and will continue until the job is completed. This work will consist of a full tear-off of the vinyl siding, window, and door trim, and all penetration accessories. The moisture barrier wrap will be removed and any deteriorated sheathing will be replaced. Decks without ledger flashing will have new flashing installed. This will require a few deck boards to be removed so the flashing can be installed on the ledger board.

Please ensure all personal items are removed from your decks and along the back elevation of the building. Atlas will be held harmless for any damage to items not moved.

How to prepare for a siding project and what to expect

- KEEP CHILDREN AND PETS AWAY FROM THE WORK AREA. DANGER KEEP OUT!
- 2. Be prepared for the noise. Crews generally start early in the morning. There will be constant hammering during the construction process.
- Remove all loose items from wall shelves and walls on the back elevation.Hammering creates vibrations that may cause items to shift, move and fall.
- 4. Remove all items from around the exterior of your home where work will be completed. All reasonable efforts are made to protect personal items and landscaping, but construction debris will fall and cause damage to these items. Atlas will be held harmless for any damaged items not removed before work starts.
- Access to your parking lot/driveway will be needed to load and unload materials and for job site cleanup.
- 6. Large delivery trucks may be needed to load and unload materials and dumpsters.
- The use of power tools may be needed to complete the approved work. Access to an outlet may be needed. Please notify us if you have any concerns about this.
- 8. Daily cleanup of the job site will be completed. Every effort to pick up nails is made. Magnetic rollers are used, but a few nails may be hidden in the grass.
- Communication and responsiveness are a top priority. Please feel free to contact us with any questions or concerns you may have. Our mission is to provide high-quality work with as little impact on your community as possible.
